The Institute of Liberal Arts and Science, Kanazawa University invites applications for a faculty position teaching English language classes and English Academic Literacy classes as professor, associate professor, or lecturer.

- 1. **Open Position**: One professor, associate professor, or assistant professor (5 year limited-term position. There is a possibility of a contract renewal. See 13. for details.)
- 2. Affiliation: Faculty of Foreign Language Studies, Institute of Liberal Arts and Science

3. Main Duties:

- 1) Teaching English language classes in the liberal arts curriculum and English academic literacy classes (up to six 90-minute classes per week).
- 2) Designing/Planning and coordinating English courses.
- 3) Developing English course materials.
- 4) Conducting joint research on foreign language education and on teaching material development for English language courses.
- 5) Taking part in faculty/institutional projects.
- 6) Undertaking other duties as designated by the head of the faculty.

4. Academic Fields:

English language education, Academic literacy education (CLIL, CBI, etc.), Literature and culture of English-speaking worlds, English linguistics and other related areas,

5. **Status of Employment**: Fixed-term (5 years)

There is a possibility of a contract renewal depending on the result of a contract renewal review.

6. Qualifications:

- 1) Applicants should have a doctoral degree or is in the process of obtaining a doctoral degree
- 2) Applicants should have teaching experience at the tertiary level and an ability to teach in English.
- 3) Applicants should have knowledge, experience and abilities in the areas of English language education and other academic literacy skills, as well as a cooperative attitude towards collaboration with other faculty, administrative staff, and the local community in conducting education and research.
- 4) Applicants should have expert command of English (equivalent to CEFR C2 level).
- 5) Sufficient proficiency in Japanese to conduct daily business with university staff is desirable.
- 6) A successful candidate is required to reside in Kanazawa or in its surrounding vicinity, when employed.
- 7. Start of Employment: October 1st, 2023 or April 1st, 2024

8. Application Documents:

- 1) Curriculum vitae, including the following:
 - a) Full name, contact address, phone number, and an email address.
 - b) Educational background from high school graduation to the highest academic degree obtained, including the year and month of the start and end of each educational program.
 - c) Employment history, including the year and month of the start and end of each employment.
 - d) Teaching/research experiences or other long-term working experiences in English-speaking

- societies (please include names of institutions, locations and periods of time).
- e) Scores of tests certifying the candidate's English or Japanese language proficiency, if any. (Copies of result sheet is preferable.)
- 2) List of educational and research achievements (circle the item number for peer-reviewed papers), and details of any competitive research grants you have obtained (including the name of the funding organization; the research project title; total amount of money granted; year of grant receipt; your role in the research project, i.e., principal investigator or co-investigator). Please list books, articles, and book reviews and other shorter materials separately. Write the newest publication first followed by older materials/items.
- 3) A copy of one major research achievement, such as a book, published paper, etc. and its summary/abstract.
 - * Candidates may be asked to submit additional materials.
- 4) An essay outlining your research interests and achievements, including future research plan at Kanazawa University (A4 1 page).
- 5) An essay on your experiences in education and future aspirations at Kanazawa University (A4 1 page).
- 6) The names, institutional affiliations, positions, and contact details (telephone numbers and e-mail addresses) of two personal references.
